Experience Grand Rapids

- Attraction passes for 2024 have been sent to hoteliers to pass out to guests. Any issues with the digital pass connect with Jaylyn for anything with these passes and codes.
- RSVP for the annual Tourism Meeting on March 19 at Frederik Meijer Gardens, if you have not yet. The meeting will also include Happy Hour and then free admission to the Butterflies are Blooming exhibit.
- Experience Grand Rapids & Pure Michigan are working with Brand USA on a new free platform for group tour operators called "Tourism Exchange".

Grand Rapids Diversity & Inclusion

- Working on a learning management system to give frontline workers exposure to customer service training. The
 ideal platform is to give them modules, information about different cultural events or important dates to connect to
 guests with.
- Working on expanding their academy for hospitality and tourism. Looking into expansion into 5 schools this year.
 Took a trip to Miami to see how they operate those schools.
- Looking for teachers. Reach out to Jordoun for introductions. Looking for internships for high-school employees. If you want to host or go in and be a guest speaker please reach out!

- Timeline: NAF creates the curriculum, and a year of planning will start and wrap up in 2025 and launch with 2025-2026 academic year.
- Will the curriculum change for the current schools involved? What is the timeline for guest speakers?
 - The district chooses how to bring in their curriculum to the schools' current guidelines. 2x a month working on a different engagement with the current students whether it be a guest speaker or taking the kids on a field trip.
- How can KCHA get involved?
 - Offer to visit the classroom during the school year.

Michigan Restaurant & Lodging Association

- Capital Day is May 8 in Lansing.
- Hospitality Training is updated. The course is hybrid. Have really finalized the dates to give a heads up for the time commitment. Completely free and a \$500 bonus when you complete for the first 2,000 participants.
- Alliance: It was announced that there is \$50 million in Pure Michigan funding. Actually, only \$15 million is earmarked for Pure Michigan as the marketing arm of tourism through MEDC. The rest is going to a development partnership utilizing the "Pure Michigan" branding.
- Feb. 13, lawmakers introduced a 10-bill package (HB 5437-5446 Short Term Rental Reform) intended to regulate Michigan's short term rental market. Although the bills as passed would allow local taxes; none of the funds generated by short-term rental taxes will help promote tourism in MI which remains underfunded by the MI legislature and a top priority for the MRLA.

Michigan Cares for Tourism

- Mini clean-up project in April in Kalamazoo in partnership with the Pure Michigan Tourism Conference. The group will be working with the Kalamazoo Growlers and building wiffleball fields.
- The main volunteer event is Monday, May 20 on Belle Isle in Detroit (with a local charter school) as part of National Tourism Week. Working on transportation and hotel details.
